Clinical Histories

1. (Dr. P. Lin) 26 year old man with skin and upper respiratory infections since childhood, some requiring multiple courses of antibiotics, ER visits and hospitalizations. Family history is significant for psoriasis in one sister and rheumatoid arthritis and multiple sclerosis in his mother.
2. (Dr. K. Gaal) 76 year old with leukocytosis with monocytosis, anemia, and lymphadenopathy.
3. (Dr. W. Wang) Two patients with no significant prior medical history, both presenting with leukocytosis with circulating blasts.
4. (Dr. K. Gaal) Another 76 year old with leukocytosis, anemia and lymphadenopathy.
